Display of radiation monitoring devices in Tokyo and Sendai

JAEA presented radiation monitoring devices at the “2012 Exhibition for Geo-Environmental Restoration” held at Tokyo Big Sight over the three-day period from October 17 to 19, combined with information on its environmental monitoring initiatives and the state of development of measurement devices. This exhibition on environmental issues was organized by the Geo-Environmental Protection Center and Nikkan Kogyo Shimbun.

The similar display was also shown at “Eco-Products in Tohoku 2012” held in Sendai City by the Chamber of Environment (incorporated non-profit organization) over the three-day period from October 19 to 21.

The Agency booths consisted of seven panels on show in the corner titled “Initiatives for environmental restoration of Fukushima” at both exhibitions. Information was included on decontamination model demonstrations projects, radiation monitoring by unmanned helicopter, measurement of radiation distribution using plastic scintillation fibers (PSF), widespread radiation monitoring using aircraft, and gamma plotter H that is able to create land-based dose-rate maps. Also the actual unmanned helicopter was displayed at “Eco-Products in Tohoku 2012”.
